Few performers can boast a set list as impressive as Randy Bachman and Burton Cummings. Collectively and individually, Bachman Cummings' catalogue is the envy of every artist. The Guess Who, Bachman-Turner Overdrive, Burton Cummings solo: together theirs is the Great Canadian Songbook and an integral chapter of the Manitoba story.

Members of the Canadian Music Hall of Fame, Canadian Songwriters Hall of Fame, Canadian Broadcasters Hall of Fame, the Canadian Walk of Fame, the first ever inductees into the Prairie Music Hall of Fame, recipients of the Order of Canada, the Order of Manitoba, the Governor General's Performing Arts Award and several Broadcast Music Industry awards for over 1 million airplays, Randy Bachman and Burton Cummings are Canadian rock 'n' roll royalty.

The Manitoba 150 Host Committee is also excited to announce that Unite 150 is presented by Bell MTS, with support from the Government of Canada and the Province of Manitoba.

Held in front of the Manitoba Legislative Building on Broadway Avenue and Memorial Boulevard, Unite 150 is presented by Bell MTS, with the festivities live streamed on CTVWinnipeg.ca for home viewing or community gatherings across the province.
